



FOOTBALL POLICY AGREEMENT



Thank you for joining Middletown Youth Football & Cheerleading.

UNIFORMS: All players are loaned their uniform consisting of practice and game jerseys, practice pant, game pant, mouthpiece, helmet, knee/thigh/hip/tail pads, shoulder pads and a belt. At the end of the season all uniform pieces must be returned within two weeks of the last game played. If leaving the team during the season, the uniform must be returned immediately.

There will be a replacement cost for losing or damage to uniforms beyond normal wear and tear. No alterations, labeling, etc. are allowed on any helmet or uniform piece.

- a. Any game jersey that is damaged/lost will result in a \$100 replacement cost.
- b. Any practice jersey that is damaged/lost will result in a \$45 replacement cost.
- c. Any helmet that is lost will result in a \$225 replacement cost.
- d. Any shoulder pad lost/damaged will result in a \$75 replacement cost.
- e. Any game pant lost will result in a \$65 replacement cost (Tiny Mite \$50)
- f. Any practice pant lost will result in a \$35 replacement cost.
- g. All other pads lost/damaged will result in a \$5 to \$20 replacement cost.
- h. Uniforms must be returned immediately upon dismissal from the team.
- i. Uniforms will only be worn during official Pop Warner events and will not be worn by family members, friends or siblings..
- j. Do no bleach uniforms. Hang dry – do not put uniforms in the dryer.

GUIDELINES/REQUIREMENTS:

Practices: Practice starts August 1st. Practice is normally Monday thru Friday, 5:30 to 7:30 pm at Gaudet field during August. Non-competitive teams may practice less. Coaches will inform of practice schedules. After Labor Day practices will be Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at Gaudet Field. Non-competitive teams may practice less.

Code of Conduct: All players and parents/guardians/family members will follow the Pop Warner standards of conduct. Coaches, teammates, opponents will be treated with respect and dignity. Profanity, fighting (physical or verbal), emails or other communications that lead to confrontations/complaints will result in disciplinary action/suspension/expulsion from the program.

Attendance: Football is a team sport and a commitment. Attendance at games and practices are mandatory. Absences affect the entire team. Absences may result in suspension from part or all of a game and excessive absences will result in dismissal from the team. Coaches must be notified of any legitimate absences – do not just tell a friend.

Safety: Report all injuries/concerns to the coach. We follow the Heads Up Football protocols and our coaches are certified. You will be advised of requirements of medical releases, policies, etc. in case of injuries.
